New Student Registration

This guide is to assist students in creating a NelsonNet student account.

Students will require a student access code in order to register an account with NelsonNet. Your access codes is located at the back of printed books or can be purchased in a student access card.

Step one

Go to www.nelsonnet.com.au and select **“Create a new student account”**



Step two

Complete all of the details and click **“Save”**
