

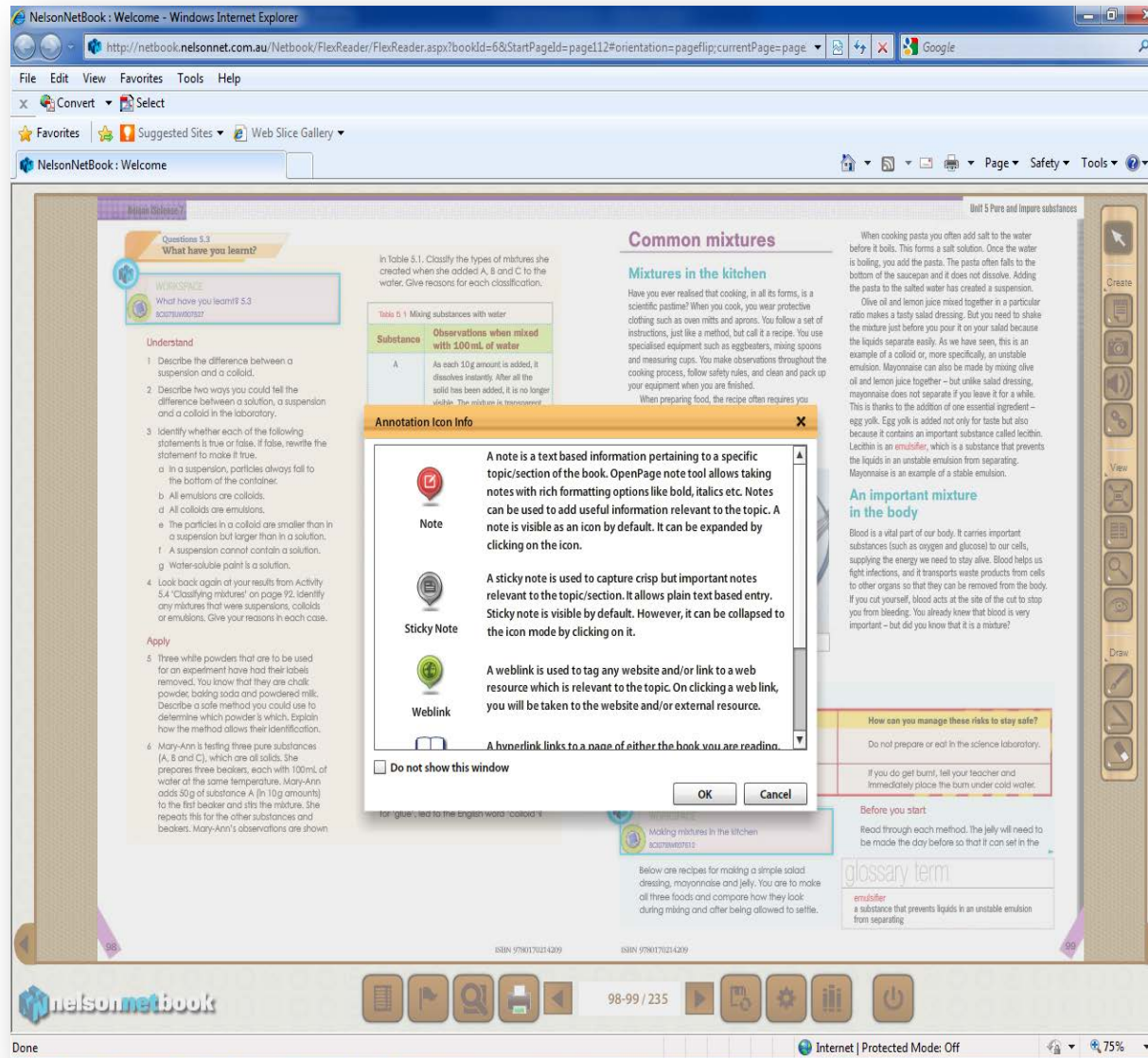

This box can be turned off.

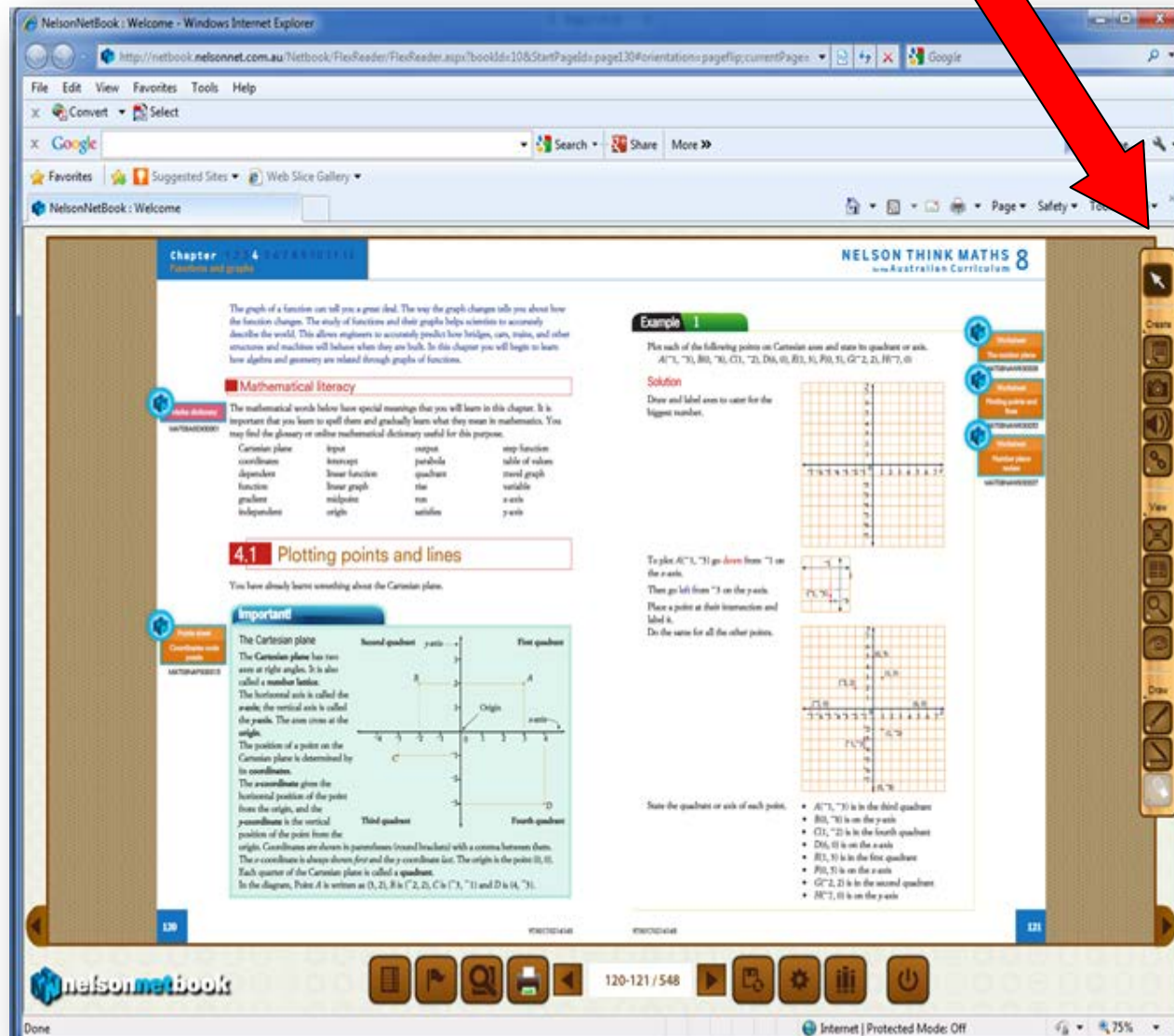


## Tools
